First Aider

On facilitated camps, Camp Zenith facilitators have first aid training. For self-facilitated programmes, ensure that you have an appointed and trained first aider on hand.

First Aid Kit

On a facilitated camp, our team keeps a first aid kit close at hand. For self-facilitated camps, have a first aid kit handy. We keep a first-aid kit in our office. But having an additional kit may help in the case of emergencies away from the office.

Camp Zenith indemnity forms

Before your camp, you'll receive an easy-to-complete online indemnity form. Share this with your campers, to gather vital info, such as allergies/medical conditions and emergency contacts.

Your own indemnity forms

Your church/school may have its indemnity form. It's a good idea to get this filled out by your campers in addition to our indemnity form. The Camp Zenith indemnity form also covers your organisation.

Driver Certification

If you are hiring a bus, ask for a copy of the PDP licence of the drivers, and road-worthy certificate of the bus. You don't want to be putting your campers at risk should the bus company not be able to provide these items.

Health and safety certificate

Annually, Camp Zenith is inspected for health and safety.

Allergies of campers

Recording the allergies of your campers, especially food allergies, can save lives. Remember to communicate these clearly to the campsite management and/or head of catering. The Camp Zenith indemnity form does this for you.

Medical conditions of campers

Any medical conditions of campers should be reported to camp manager and programme director.

Pool Safety

Be sure to know if any of your campers can't swim. We have a lifesaving ring available in case of emergency. Designate life guards who are strong swimmers to watch campers swim. Life guards to watch from the outside of the pool.
